- 3. Allow to air dry then cover wound with a non-adherent dressing. Gauze is recommended as the secondary dressing if removing debris from wound site. Superficial wounds may not require a secondary dressing due to the film that hyCURE® ORAL GEL forms on the wound site after drying.
- 4. Remove dressing as needed (if secondary dressing sticks to wound, soak in warm water to ease removal) and repeat procedure.
